NOTIFICATION

S.O. 1609.- In pursuance of clause (1) of article 239 of the Constitution and in supersession of the notification of the Government of India in the Ministry of Home Affairs No. S.R.O. 1531, dated the 14th May, 1957, the President hereby directs that the Administrator of every Union territory (whether known as Administrator, Chief Commissioner or Lieutenant Governor) shall, subject to the control of the President and until further orders, also exercise the powers and discharge the functions of the Central Government under section 7 of the Explosive Substances Act, 1908 (6 of 1908), within that Union territory.
