G.S.R- In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution, the President hereby makes the following rules to amend the Directorate of Coordination Police Wireless, (Director) Recruitment Rules, 2007, namely :-

1. Short title and commencement. (1) these rules may be called the Directorate of Coordination Police Wireless, (Director) Amendment Recruitment Rules 2017.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. In the Directorate of Coordination Police Wireless (Director) Recruitment Rules 2007, in rule 2, for the words 'Pay band and Grade Pay or Pay Scale', the words "LEVEL in the PAY MATRIX" shall be substituted.

3. In the Schedule to the Directorate of Coordination Police Wireless (Director) Recruitment Rules, 2007. __

(A) in column 4. __

(a) for the heading, the heading "LEVEL in the PAY MATRIX" shall be substituted;

(b) for the entries, the entries "LEVEL 14 in the PAY MATRIX " shall be substituted.

(B) in column 12. __

under the sub-heading Promotion. __

i) for the words, letters and figures "in pay band 4 Rs.37400-67000 plus grade pay Rs.8700", the words, letters and figures "LEVEL 13 in the PAY MATRIX" shall be substituted.

ii) In Note 1, for the dates "1-1-2006", the dates "1-1-2016" shall be substituted and for the words "Sixth" and "grade pay or pay scale", the words "Seventh" and "LEVEL in the PAY MATRIX" shall be substituted respectively.

(C) in column 12. __

under the sub-heading Deputation. __

- (a) The existing title namely "Officers under the Central or State Governments or Union Territories:" and paragraph (a) and (b) shall be changed/replaced with following paragraphs A) and B):

b) Possessing the following educational qualifications and experience:

Bachelor's degree in Engineering or Bachelor's degree in Technology in Electronics or Telecommunications or Computer or Information Technology from a recognized university or equivalent with fifteen years' experience in Radio Communication, Computer Communication or Satellite Communication; or

Master's degree in Engineering or Master's degree in Technology in Electronics or Telecommunication or Computer or information Technology from a Recognized University or equivalent with thirteen years' experience in Radio Communication, Computer Communication or Satellite Communication.

- (b) in Note, for the dates "1-1-2006", the dates "1-1-2016" shall be substituted and for the words "Sixth" and "grade pay or pay scale", the words "Seventh" and "LEVEL in the PAY MATRIX" shall be substituted respectively.

(D) in column 14. _

- (a) for the entries, the entries, "Consultation with Union Public Service Commission is not necessary while filling the post through IPS Officer on deputation.

Otherwise Consultation with Union Public Service Commission is necessary while appointing a non-IPS officer on deputation." Shall be substituted.
