MANDATE

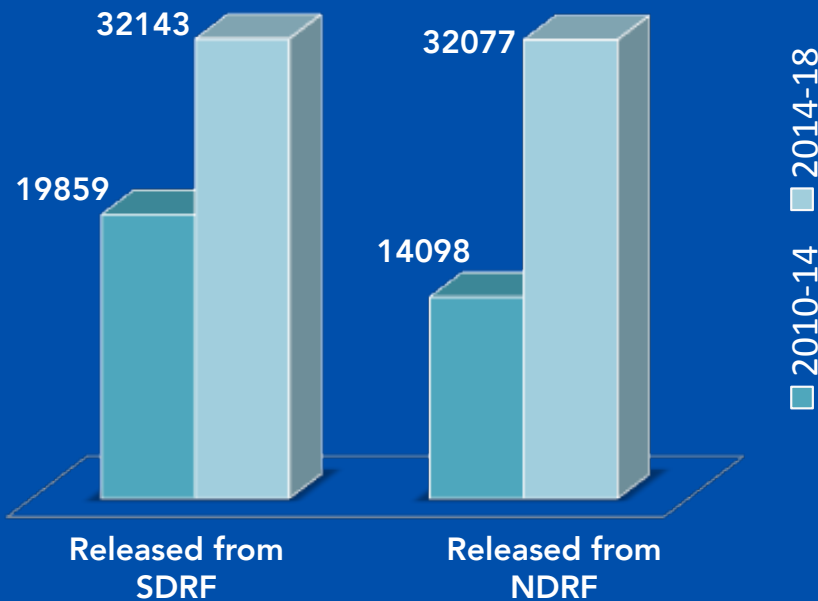

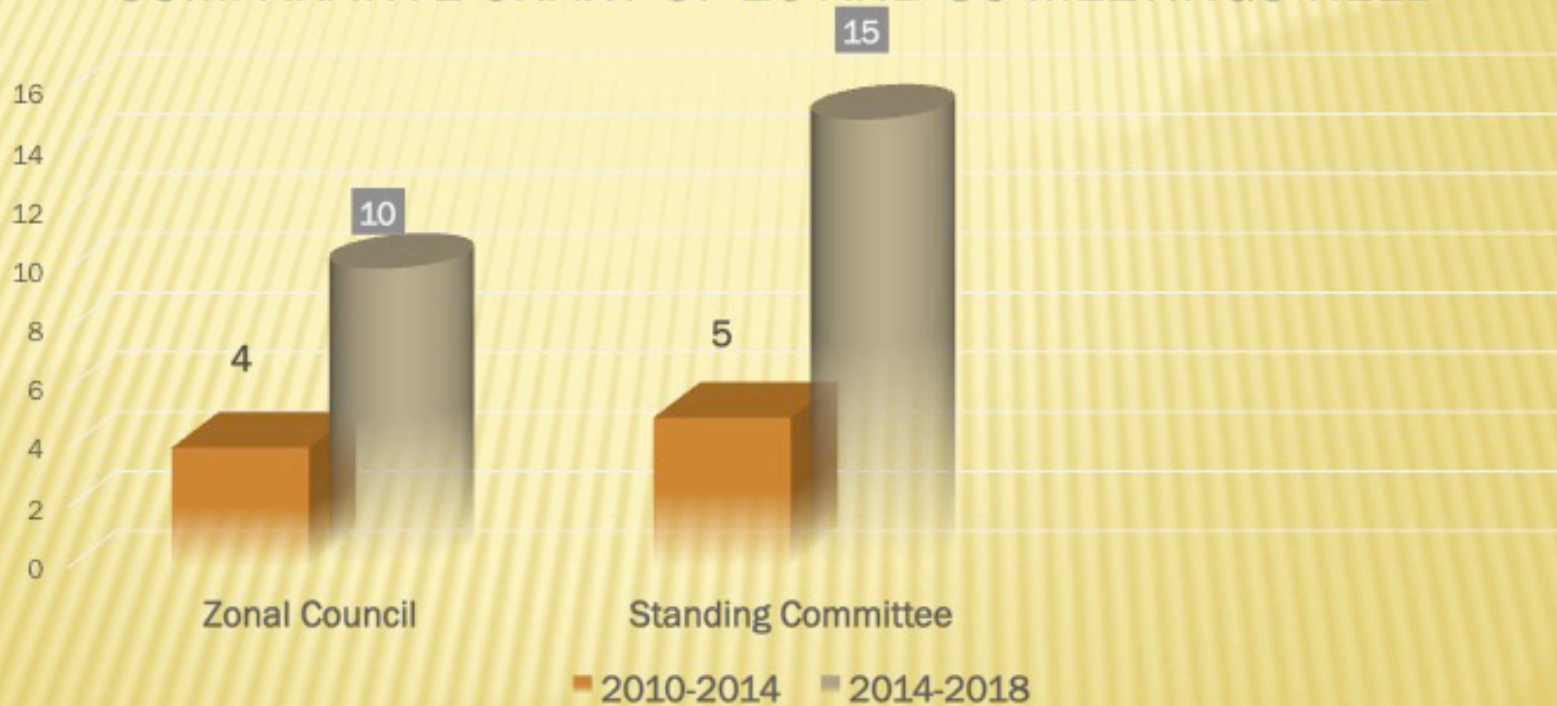
