**Home Minister of Maldives calls on Shri Amit Shah in New Delhi today**

**New Delhi, February 21, 2020**

Home Minister of Maldives, Mr. Sheikh Imran Abdulla, called on Union Minister for Home Affairs, Shri Amit Shah, in New Delhi today.
